Cost: £5 per session

If you are interested in booking a place, please register your interest through the school office.

Please note, if your child attends Drum Club on a Wednesday morning and you wish for them to also join the Breakfast Club, we are happy to accommodate this. The cost for doing so is £1.50, which will cover the care cost from 7.45-8am as well as breakfast for your child.

Payment for the month ahead must be made in advance for the whole month via the Gateway app.

On Thursday 8th May, we will be commemorating VE day; giving children the opportunity to learn about the significance of this historic event.
