SEND Roadshow

Leicestershire Partnership NHS Trust partnered with the Solihull Approach back in 2023 to offer a range of free courses to support parents, carers and professionals. The courses provide advice and support about physical and mental health, understanding children's feelings, how to build better relationships – as well as issues that affect children with additional needs, learning disabilities and autism. In the past two years, we have seen over 2,000 people access the courses, with the feedback being overwhelmingly positive;
