The Year 1 children have been very busy getting creative and working in teams.

In Art, the children have been learning all about primary and secondary colours, how to mix different shades, and use these colours to create different effects. They completed their 'Colour Splash' unit by designing their own Clarice Cliff inspired plates.

In Design Technology, we made our own healthy smoothies by selecting the fruit we wanted to include. The children taste tested a range of fruit, and made their selections based on a balance of sweet and sour flavours. The children then took part in chopping, mixing and blending their creations.

This week in Music, the children have been learning about the characteristics that make up sound. They have been experimenting with pulse, tempo and dynamics, creating their own rhythms.

If you wish to attend this day, please email or contact the office and advise us how many visitors we are to expect.

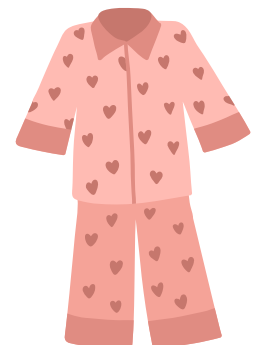
Pyjamarama
